

SET DEPARTURE: Patagonia and the End-of-the-World Cruise



Day 1: Buenos Aires

Arrive in Buenos Aires and transfer to your hotel before setting off on a panoramic city tour. Visit historic Plaza de Mayo, wander through the vibrant, mural-covered streets of La Boca, and explore the elegant neighborhoods of Palermo and Recoleta. In the evening, enjoy a dazzling tango dinner show with the option to join in a dance lesson and step into the rhythm of Argentina.



Day 2: Buenos Aires

A full day at leisure to explore Buenos Aires your way—dive into its rich history, savor local flavors, browse artisan shops, or simply enjoy the rhythm of city life.



Day 3: Buenos Aires → Ushuaia

Fly to Ushuaia, the southernmost city on Earth. Nestled between the Andes and the Beagle Channel, this wild frontier is your gateway to Patagonia—where glaciers, forests, and rugged peaks meet at the edge of the world.



Day 4: Ushuaia → Australis Cruise

Begin the day with a scenic excursion through Tierra del Fuego National Park, where breathtaking mountain views, lush lenga forests, and colorful wildflowers line the path to the Beagle Channel. Wander among iconic notro and cherry trees, and keep watch for playful sea lions and adorable penguins. In the afternoon, return to Ushuaia to complete boarding formalities, then transfer to the port, and step aboard your expedition cruise ship.



Day 5: Australis Cruise: Cape Horn & Wulaia Bay

Sail through the Murray Channel and Nassau Bay to reach the fabled Cape Horn, where you'll set foot on one of the most remote and iconic landmarks on Earth—known as the “World's End” and a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. In the afternoon, continue to Wulaia Bay, a once-thriving settlement of the Yámana people. Wander through lush landscapes to a panoramic viewpoint and take in the dramatic beauty that defines Patagonia's untamed spirit.



Day 6: Australis Cruise: Pía Glacier & Garibaldi Glacier

Begin your day sailing through the dramatic northwestern stretch of the Beagle Channel, arriving at Pía Fjord. From there, set out on a hike to a stunning panoramic viewpoint, where the immense glacier spills down from the mountains into the sea—an unforgettable display of Patagonia’s raw beauty. In the afternoon, continue into the serene Garibaldi Fjord for a more intimate adventure. Walk through pristine forest trails to reach the base of a powerful glacial waterfall, where nature’s force and stillness collide. After a day of breathtaking encounters, return to the ship to relax and reflect on the wonders you’ve just witnessed.



Day 7: Australis Cruise: Agostini Sound, Águila & Cóndor Glaciers

Venture into the remote beauty of Agostini Sound, where towering glaciers spill from the Darwin Mountain Range into the sea. In the morning, ride a Zodiac boat to Águila Glacier, then enjoy a gentle walk around a peaceful lagoon, surrounded by ice-carved peaks and still waters—a quiet, spellbinding moment in the wild. In the afternoon, cruise toward the striking Cóndor Glacier, drawing closer to its shimmering walls as you learn how these mighty rivers of ice have shaped Patagonia’s dramatic landscape over millennia.



Day 8: Australis Cruise: Magdalena Island & Transfer to Puerto Natales

Weather permitting, begin your day with a visit to Magdalena Island, a former sailors' outpost turned wildlife sanctuary. Walk alongside a lively colony of Magellanic penguins as they waddle and play en route to the island's iconic lighthouse—an unforgettable wildlife encounter. After this unforgettable experience, you'll arrive in Punta Arenas at approximately 11:30 AM, where shuttles will be ready to transfer you comfortably to Puerto Natales—offering a seamless transition into the next leg of your Patagonian journey.



Day 9: Puerto Natales: Torres del Paine National Park

Embark on a full-day adventure through Torres del Paine, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve since 1978 and one of the world's most spectacular landscapes. Marvel at the shimmering beauty of Lakes Sarmiento, Nordenskjöld, and Pehoé, all set against jagged mountain peaks. Along the way, watch for guanacos, foxes, and soaring birdlife. Enjoy a scenic walk to Salto Grande, a powerful waterfall nestled within the park's intricate waterways. Later, continue to Lake Grey and stroll through native forest to the shoreline, where towering icebergs from the Grey Glacier rest in turquoise waters—a surreal and unforgettable sight. A boxed lunch is included to fuel your journey. In the evening, return to Puerto Natales for a relaxing night at your hotel.



Day 10: Puerto Natales → El Calafate

Upon arrival in El Calafate, you will be greeted by a shuttle and transferred to your hotel.



Day 11: El Calafate: Perito Moreno Glacier

Explore the breathtaking Perito Moreno Glacier, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in the stunning Los Glaciares National Park. This massive glacier spans 257 square kilometers, with its front wall rising 50 to 60 meters above the lake. Embark on a guided walk along the viewing platforms to experience the glacier from different angles and admire its awe-inspiring beauty. Afterward, enjoy free time for lunch (not included) before returning to your hotel in the afternoon. Don't miss the chance to witness this natural wonder up close!



Day 12: El Calafate → Buenos Aires

Free morning to enjoy El Calafate. At due time, transfer to the airport to board the scheduled flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival, reception, and transfer to the hotel.



Day 13: Buenos Aires
