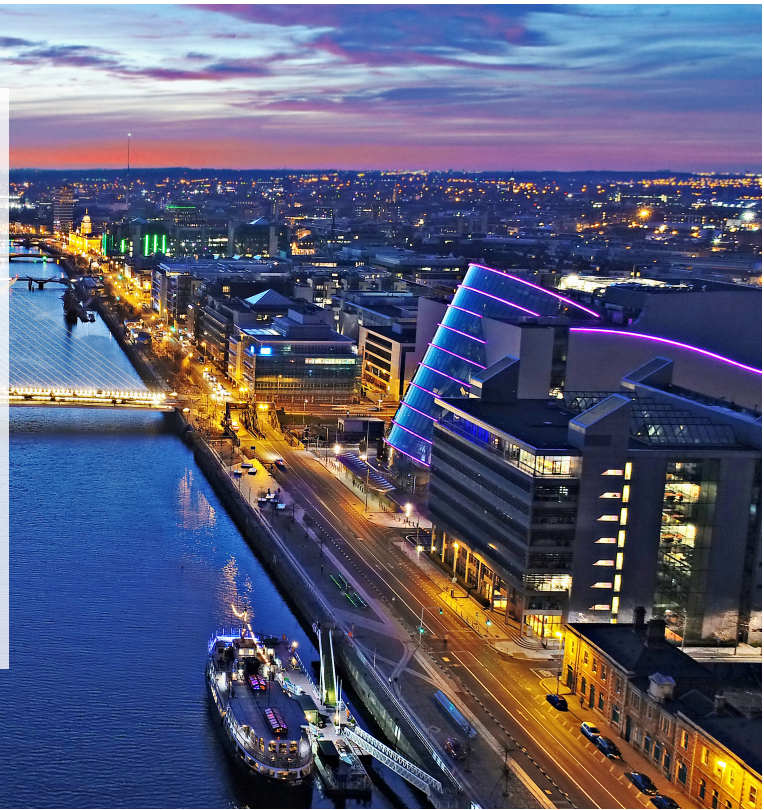


DUBLIN & BELFAST

DERRY & DONEGAL

DAY 5. GIANTS CAUSEWAY

Marvel at the breathtaking Giant's Causeway, home to approximately 40,000 ancient basalt columns formed by volcanic activity. Afterward, continue your journey to the historic Bushmills Distillery, one of the world's oldest distilleries, where you'll learn about the art of whiskey-making and sample its renowned spirits.

DAY 6. DONEGAL

Take a captivating walking tour of the historic walled city of Derry, rich in history and charm. Then, travel to Donegal to explore the stunning Glenveagh National Park, spanning 16,000 hectares in the majestic Derryveagh Mountains, before visiting the impressive Glenveagh Castle. Overnight: Donegal.

DAY 7. DUBLIN

Travel back to Dublin, passing through the scenic Fermanagh Lake District. Stop to explore Castle Coole, an elegant 18th-century mansion surrounded by stunning landscapes. Then, venture underground to the Marble Arch Caves, one of Europe's most spectacular natural wonders, offering a fascinating glimpse into the world beneath the earth's surface.
