After your time in the city, you will set sail from the Port of Lavrion to explore the Greek Islands and the coast of Turkey. From walking the medieval streets of Rhodes to seeing the famous blue domes of Santorini, each stop brings ancient history to life.

You will stay for three nights at the Titania Hotel (or similar), a high-end property in the center of Athens. For the cruise portion, you will have an Exterior Stateroom on the Celestyal fleet, giving you private views of the sea. All travel between the airport, the hotel, and the cruise port is handled by private car for a smooth, stress-free experience.
